Patient Financial Responsibilities:

- Patients without insurance coverage are required to make a payment at the time of service.
- Patients with insurance coverage must pay their deductible at first visit, along with their co-pay amount if applicable. As a courtesy we will file your insurance claim for you.
- Patients are responsible for the complete payment of their account regardless of insurer's determination of coverage or reimbursement.
- If you are covered by an insurance plan, you must provide a valid insurance card at time of check in. You also must provide us with any changes to your insurance coverage.
- Payment can be made with cash, check, Visa, and Mastercard.
- We do offer 0% financing for one year if approved through CareCredit, available for extensive treatment.

All fees for services rendered are the patient's responsibility.

Billing Policy

- All un-paid insurance claims beyond 45 days from date of service will become your responsibility. If we have not been able to collect from your insurance company you will be billed for the entire balance.
- Balances 90 days from the date of service (unless previous arrangements have been made) will be considered a collection issue and a finance charge can be assessed.
- Appointment cancellation with less than 48 hour notice, or failed confirmed appointments, are subject to a cancellation fee charged to your account.

Patients who are under the age of 18 years old cannot be treated unless accompanied by a parent or guardian. A written consent by the parent or guardian is acceptable.

I understand and agree that, regardless of my insurance status after 90 days from the date of service, I am responsible for the balance on my account for services rendered unless prior arrangements have been made. I have read and understand all of the above information, and accept the terms of the financial and billing policies.
